A note from the president....

This September has been a hard and shocking month. The news of Charlie Kirk's assassination shook me deeply. For so many of us in the pro-life movement, Charlie was a steady, logical voice—someone who could reach younger people in a way that few others could. His loss has left a huge hole, and I find myself asking the same question many others are asking: Where do we go from here?

The truth is, I don't have a simple answer. Maybe none of us do. But what I keep coming back to is this: God is still in control. He made Charlie Kirk, and He is more than able to raise up a million more voices just as strong. There's even a new movement where people are saying, "I am Charlie Kirk." That reminds me of Matthew 3:9, where John the Baptist said, "Do not think you can say to yourselves, 'We have Abraham as our father.' I tell you that out of these stones God can raise up children for Abraham."

Charlie was a gift, but God's work doesn't stop with one man. He has given each of us gifts too. And now might be the moment to ask ourselves: how can *I* step up? How can *you*? Maybe it's starting conversations on a college campus, serving at a Women's Resource Center, or simply walking alongside a mother who feels alone and afraid. Wherever God has placed us, He's done it with purpose.

The fact that we're still here, still breathing, means He's not finished with us yet. That thought gives me hope. It tells me we can keep carrying the message forward—that every life has value, every life has purpose. And if Charlie Kirk was a logical voice to the masses, then maybe we can each be a voice too, in our own corner of the world.

Let's honor his legacy not just by mourning, but by rising up, speaking truth, and shining light. God still has work for us to do.



No Shame, No Blame, No Name

If a mother has thoughts of abandoning her infant or is unable to keep her infant after birth, she now has a safe option, Safe Haven. Infants up to 30 days old can be legally handed to staff at hospitals, emergency facilities, police station or fire station under the Illinois Abandoned Newborn Infant Protection Act. The mother does not have to give any information, is not breaking any law, no police is called and the infant will be adopted.




